



## NIGHT DAISY

### **Workshop Description:**

What better way to construct this rich Night Daisy piece than using petal templates or freeform cutting to create lots of petals. Let the fabric be your guide. Explore the fabric for just the right lines, veins, color & texture. Learn to translating your petals into a composition filled with transparencies and depth. Fusing & gluing will be used to construct a small wall hanging. No Sewing machine required for class.

**Length:** 1 day

**Level:** All levels (Basis sewing skills required)

**Techniques:** Fusing

**Class size:** 20 Students (Maximum 25 if class room space allows)

### **Physical Requirements and Equipment for Classroom:**

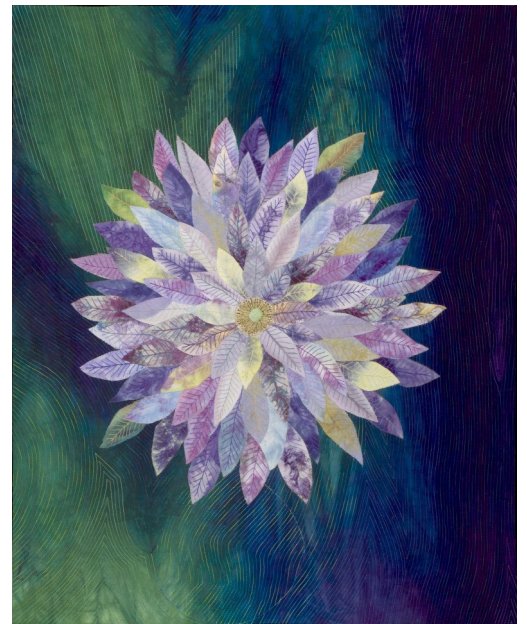
- Per student: 4' X 8' wall space that tape or pins can be used
- Sufficient table space for sewing machine, fabric and elbow room
- 2-3 irons and ironing boards

### **Tools and Supplies:**

- Straight Pins
  - Small sharp pointed fabric scissors
  - Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
  - 2 yards Fusible— 17 or 18" wide
  - Basting Glue Stick
  - Black permanent ink felt tip pen - Sharpie extra fine point is best
  - Optional: A low wattage wand mini iron

### **Fabric:**

- 3/4 yard background fabric
- For Feathers: 15 or more pieces of fabric: It can be 1/4yds or fat quarters or a jelly roll. Fabrics with lines/veins, textures and shading, in lights & mediums
- 1/4 yard novelty print with interesting motifs for the center
